



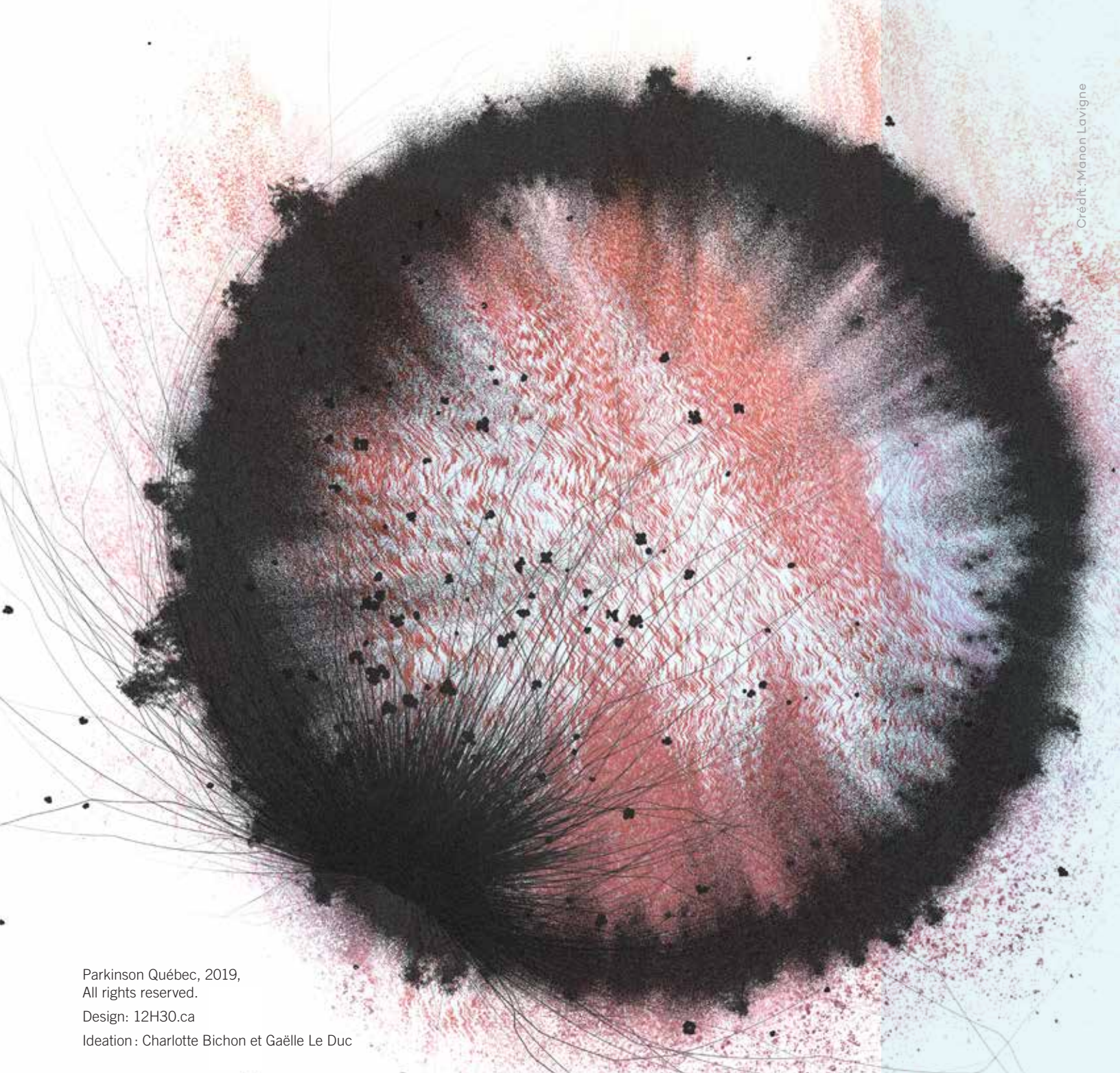

We answered your calls and met with you throughout all of Quebec. We are listening to your informational needs and supporting you through conferences or by backing your activities close to home.

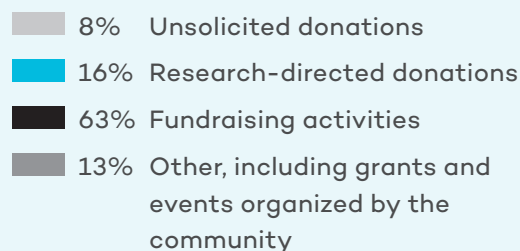
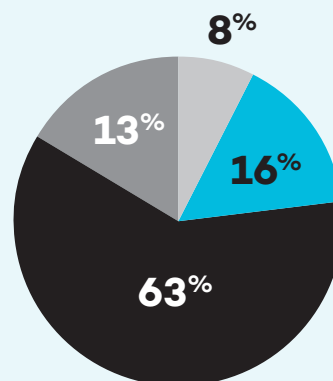

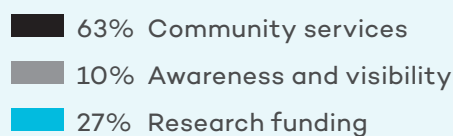

## RIGHTS ADVOCACY

Parkinson Québec has always invested in research to find a cure for Parkinson's disease. In 2019, your donations also allowed us to take action to counter one of the causes of the disease: pesticide exposure. On September 26, 2019 Parkinson Québec was invited to a public hearing of the parliamentary commission that assesses the impact of pesticides on health to present the recommendations made in its brief. These recommendations are aimed at protecting all citizens from the impact of pesticides, as well as compensating people who were exposed and subsequently developed the disease.

### *Our demands:*

- **recognition of Parkinson's disease as an occupational disease**
- **creation of a compensation fund for pesticide victims**

# RESEARCH



## Janelle Drouin-Ouellet

Janelle Drouin-Ouellet obtained her doctorate in neurobiology from Université Laval in 2012. She then earned two post doctorates, from Cambridge University (Great Britain) and Lund University (Sweden), where she worked on developing the conversion of skin cells from Parkinson's patients into brain cells to better study the disease. She is currently pursuing this work as an independent researcher at Université de Montréal.

**I initially chose to study Parkinson's for the potential of regenerative medicine to become a treatment. Transplanting new cells into patients' brains to replace lost cells seemed—and still seems—to me a fascinating approach. I then observed the incredible clinical diversity associated with this disease and especially the lack of models to study this aspect in a laboratory. This is exactly what drove me to focus on developing these tools.**

## Saucier - van Berkom research symposium

At the fourth annual research symposium held with the group of students from Université de Montréal, Dr. Martin Lévesque, PhD, gave a talk on new avenues for developing treatments for Parkinson's disease.

His research project consists of developing therapies to protect neurons from degeneration and possibly to enable the regeneration of neuron circuits from stem cells. His research project is co-funded by the QRFP.

# OUR ACTIONS



## Liaison Parkinson

The Liaison Parkinson program is a support service focused on empowerment established in 2018. It is aimed at informing and supporting people and families facing the disease regardless of its stage.

Since the program was established, more than 30 sites have referred people to our organization under the program.

The first contact, initiated by Parkinson Québec, has the goal of assessing and evaluating the needs and providing support to the referred individual. Then, we redirect them to the appropriate local resources. A subsequent telephone follow-up is scheduled with the person to assess the impact of this intervention.

## Needs assessment: taking action!

In 2018, Parkinson Québec conducted a major study to assess the needs of people living with Parkinson's disease. With close to 600 respondents, this clearly established the needs and concerns of people affected by Parkinson's. An approach focused on a continuum of services was established this year and guides the development of new programs.

In response to specific needs such as fall prevention or speech impairment, we decided to develop video clips with specialized professionals: the physiotherapy department at the CHUM, SERCOVIE, Kinatex, Neuromatrix, the rehabilitation department at Université Laval and the Université de Montréal's school of speech language pathology and audiology.

These clips will become available throughout 2020.

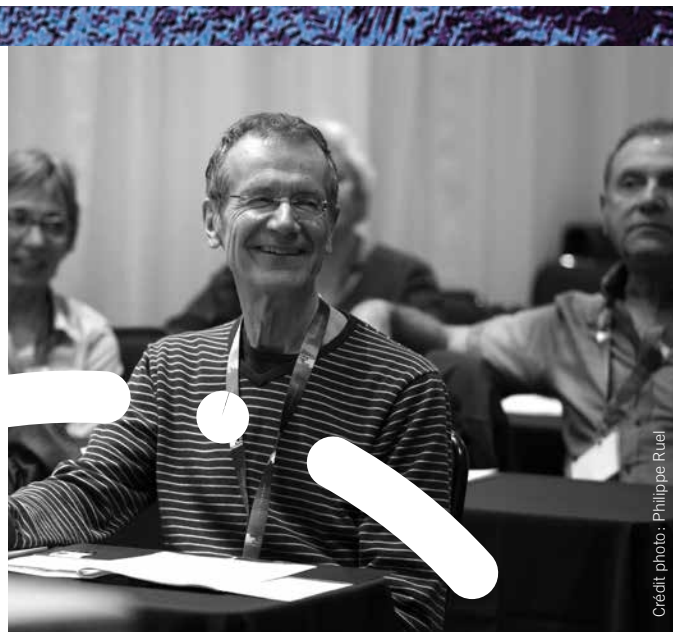




## Here for you: 1 800 720.1307

## Living with Hope conference

The 2019 conference on the theme of “Living with Hope”, held over three days in Gatineau, was a true success. It was an opportunity for close to 300 people to update their knowledge of Parkinson’s disease and experience empowerment. Attendees heard twenty-four lecturers speak on various themes, participated in discovery activities like karate or yoga and witnessed poignant and hopeful testimonials.

The 2019 conference talks will be made available as webinars throughout 2020.
